Days 1-2 (2 nights)

Arrive in Zambia's capital Lusaka and take a light aircraft flight down into the Zambezi valley and The Lower Zambezi National Park. Your first two nights in the luxury Royal Zambezi Lodge is the perfect introduction to the Zambezi and cure-all for the long flight. Wildlife abounds and excursions from this base are both rewarding and exciting.

Days 3-5 (3 nights)

Travel deep into the national park where your private 'under canvas' adventure awaits. This immersive African experience successfully marries 'every comfort' with 'truly wild'. The flexibility of a private camp means that the park is your oyster and there are multiple chances to discover wildlife by canoe, vehicle and on foot with your aptly named hosts - 'Tusk & Mane Safaris'.



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ZAMBIAN THREE RIVERS EXPEDITION

Days 6-8 (3 nights)

It's a short flight to Mfuwe and the South Luangwa National Park. Known for its prolific leopard, this wilderness straddles the oxbows and meanderings of the Luangwa River; a rich and diverse environment. Tena Tena is a luxury tented camp that epitomises everything 'safari'. Famous for its game drives and walking trails, the Luangwa is on every safari aficionado's wish list.

Days 9-11 (3 nights)

Flying via Lusaka you alight in the Busanga Plains of the Kafue River system. This mosaic of grassy seasonal floodplains extends to the horizon and its biodiversity illustrates the success of modern conservation efforts. Prey and predator abound in an idyllic setting. The Busanga Plains Bush Camp is a fitting, luxurious finale to the expedition.

Day 12

One last light aircraft flight will take you to Lusaka in time to connect with your onward flight back home. '*Kuyenda bwino*' (travel safe).
